



## All Children Need School Gardens! すべての子どもたちに学校菜園を!

In 2014, Edible Schoolyard Japan launched the Edible Schoolyard Project at Aiwa Elementary School in Tama-city, Tokyo and they have been implementing the edible education ever since. For last 22 years, this program has been known for one of the most advanced and successful Edible Education curriculum which started at the Martin Luther King Jr. Middle School in Berkeley, CA. USA The Aiwa Elementary School became the first model school for it in Japan.

The core values of this program is "Grow together, eat together, an education learning the cycle of life." and they linked this program to general academic subjects. Now all the grades learn this program at Aiwa.

This exhibition showcases how the school garden became the place to be for children and the story of the school, community and parents being united through it.
